About Seshadripuram Educational Trust :

The Seshadripuram Group of Institutions was founded originally in 1930 by two lady educational enthusiasts of Seshadripuram, viz. Smt. Anandamma and Smt. Seethamma who started a primary school with about 20 children in a two Mangalore tiled rooms in the present main Campus of Seshadripuram. The institution has grown from strength to strength and today the total student strength is about

25,000. Seshadripuram Educational Trust institutions - now numbering 32 – spread across four districts (Bengaluru, Mysuru, Tumakuru & Mandya) have been growing from strength to strength having students from kinder garden to postgraduate courses. S.F.G.C was established in 1992 by Seshadripuram Educational Trust (SET), the pioneering educational management. Founded in 1930,

SET in course of its sustained growth across nine decades, has burgeoned as the foremost educational organization in Karnataka. SET has grown as a global conglomerate of premier educational institutions and a symbol of emergent free India, catering to a total student population of over 20000.

The Trust engages more than 900 employees and provides education ranging from pre-school to post graduation and research. The mission statement of SET affirms that "*every individual from each stratum of society deserves affordable, relevant and quality education*".

The Trust constantly strives to meet this social obligation by "*inclusion and expansion of newer streams in its institutions*" and provision of world-class infrastructure. The ultimate goal of the Trust is to nurture "*knowledge that will lead to happiness, peace, harmony and prosperity.*"

HARIJAN SEVAK SANGH, NEW DELHI

It was founded in September, 1932 in the wake of Gandhiji's Epic Fast at Yervada Jail, Pune, resulting in the historic Poona Pact. The immediate historical background dates back to the Second Round Table Conference in London in 1931 when Gandhiji opposed the segregation of the depressed classes (untouchables) of the Hindu community into a separate electoral group. Gandhiji saw in it a sinister device of the British government to create a split in the Hindu community in furtherance of its policy of divide and rule.

CENTRAL GANDHI SMARAK NIDHI, NEW DELHI

On 30th January 1948 the father of free India who led us from slavery to freedom through non violence fell a victim to an assassin's bullets. The nation reeled in agony when the light that illumined for decades over the destinies of India went out. The great galaxy of national leaders took a decision to create National Trust in his memory to be called Gandhi Smarak Nidhi.

KARNATAKA GANDHI SMARAK NIDHI, BENGALURU

From 1948 to 1956 there were two units of the Gandhi Smarak Nidhi one called Karnataka unit at Hubli and the other Mysore state unit at Bangalore. After integration of all Kannada districts into one state in 1956 the two units were merged and state Board was nominated by the National Executive of the Nidhi.

The Karnataka Gandhi Smaraka Nidhi was registered as an autonomous state body for furthering the objective of perpetuating the memory and message of Gandhiji to coming generation. It planned to have an appropriate building to house the state headquarters permanently. The Government of Karnataka graciously granted a suitable site in Kumara Park adjacent to Kumara Krupa Guest House where way back in 1927 Gandhiji stayed during his visit to the old Mysore state as the honored guest of the state. The land granted by the Government was shared by the Sarva Seva Sangh and the Gandhi Smaraka Nidhi on a long lease of 30 years. In 1988 Government granted the land permanently to Nidhi.

KASTURBA GANDHI NATIONAL MEMORIAL TRUST, INDORE

The Kasthurba Gandhi National Memorial Trust (K. G. N. M. T) was established in 1945 as a result of the National endeavor, lead by Mahatma Gandhi, to address the issues of women in Rural India. The unique history of India's freedom struggle. Eminent people from all walks of life as well as the anonymous masses, mobilized their resources to set up this Trust with its Head quarters at Kasturbagram (Indore), Madyapradesh, and 22 state Branches all over the country.

GANDHI PEACE FOUNDATION, NEW DELHI

Founded in the year 1989 as the propogation wing of Gandhian thoughts, GPF conducts conducts seminars, symposiums, colloquiums, and most importantly conducts Certificate Exams on 'Gandhiji's life & Message' for thousands of school children annually.
